One of the challenges in the ministry here has always been maintaining our focus on priorities. Christ said of himself, "Upon this rock I will build my church", and the great commission focused

Building up the local congregation should always be the center piece of the ministry here and equipping the believers to grow in grace and the knowledge of our Lord and Savior our primary goal. The other aspects of the ministry we feel should be tools to this end. We have been encouraged of late that several of the young men have been showing more interest and are finally



becoming more vocal and active in their participation. It is clear that this community is somewhat hard-hearted in responding to the Gospel, but we are convinced the Lord will bring to Himself those He chooses to in His time. We also continue a bi-weekly trip to a small impoverished community 4 hours to the north where there are a few new believers and others intent on listening to the gospel.

We are actively preparing for the 2017 school year at Strong Tower Christian School. Due to the departure of our principal we are redistributing tasks and duties for the following year and are much in need of another full time English teacher to round out the program.

Peru's new government has suspended all international adoptions for the time being and Morning Star Children's Home will continue on caring for the 4 children we currently have while we await the Lord's direction regarding the future of that aspect of the ministry.
