Morning Star's Newest Arrival After a couple of weeks of deliberation with the family judge assigned to the case and the careful evaluation of his medical needs, Morning Star welcomed yesterday a two month old little boy who has had a challenging start in life. We've named him Daniel and true to his namesake he faces many obstacles in the next few months. The first of those is that his mom walked out of the hospital the day after he was born and has not been heard from since. This may have been motivated by the medical complications he was born with, the most obvious being an imperforated anus. Daniel had hardly been out of the delivery room for a day when he underwent a colostomy. Later in the week a sonogram detected he had hydrocephalus. Both obstacles can be overcome but he will face future surgeries for those. We will soon begin the medical workup to determine the best course of action.
