They were given a chance to look through clothes that had been brought for them and pick out a few items, as well as some simple toys, they had a Bible lesson, handcraft, and singing, led by our resident clown "Cafilito" who some of you may know is also our night watchman and member of the assembly, Carlos Sanchez. The local authorities and residents were very pleased with the visit which ended around 2pm. They of course asked how soon we could return. It's close enough to consider an outreach into that area, maybe some sort of Bible club for the kids, with the van being available, it makes it a very viable option.
